

# RECORD OF DISCUSSION

between

**MINISTRY FOR DEVELOPMENT OF INFORMATION  
TECHNOLOGIES AND COMMUNICATIONS  
OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN**

and

**SOFTWARE TECHNOLOGY PARKS OF INDIA**

**regarding cooperation in furthering growth  
of software and information technologies**

Ministry for Development of Information Technologies and Communications of the Republic of Uzbekistan and Software Technology Parks of India an autonomous society under Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India have a mutual interest to promote cooperation in the field of software industry development, IT-services and creation of conducive environment for IT-entrepreneurship and wish to explore cooperation in the implementation of joint projects in the field of development of high-tech park in software development and innovations in Tashkent, Uzbekistan (hereinafter referred to as "Technopark").

The two parties have reached the following understanding on the basis of establishing bilateral mutually beneficial cooperation:


1. They hereby intend to cooperate to facilitate organization and development of Technopark activities in Tashkent, implementing joint projects in the field of information technologies and software products.
2. They have expressed mutual interest in preparing the Cooperation Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") for development of joint activities in following areas:
  - a) developing Technopark in Tashkent based on best Indian experience and practices;
  - b) attracting leading Indian experts and consultants, as well as companies for the exchange of experience in the development of the Technopark;
  - c) developing modern business processes and management system into Technopark's activities;
  - d) organizing the information technologies training programs on the basis of bilateral mutual benefits;



- e) cooperating in other areas in information technology and software products as mutually agreed upon.
3. They agree to form joint working group (JWG) for preparing the draft Agreement within the 2 (two) months and agree that the scope of cooperation may be increased as per requirement.
4. The term of this co-operation shall commence on the date of issue of this record of discussion ("Effective Date") and shall terminate one (1) year thereafter unless earlier terminated by mutual agreement.
5. This record of discussion is a non-binding instrument and shall not be interpreted to create a joint venture, consortium, employment relationship or any other form of business arrangement, or any legal obligations between the parties.


